



GUM SURGERIES

Periodontal diseases range from simple gum inflammation to serious diseases which could result in major damage to the soft tissue and bone that supports the teeth. In the worst cases, teeth are lost. The main goal of treatment is to control the infection. Surgery might be necessary if inflammation and deep pockets remain, following the treatment with deep cleaning and medications. A dentist or periodontist may perform flap surgery to remove tartar deposits in deep pockets or to reduce the periodontal pocket and make it easier for the patient and the dentist to keep the area clean. In addition to flap surgery, your periodontist or dentist may suggest procedures to help regenerate any bone or gum tissue lost due to periodontitis. Patients with diseases like diabetes and habits like smoking are more prone to gum disease.

DENTAL IMPLANTS

BECAUSE SMILING SHOULDN'T BE AN OPTION.



This is the art and science of replacing extracted teeth with dental implants. The implant itself is a bio-compatible screw (often titanium) that is surgically placed into the jawbone to replace the root of a missing tooth. This screw acts as an anchor to support a false tooth (crown), bridge or denture. Implant can be placed surgically for any missing teeth, from one space to the entire mouth. At times, advanced surgical procedures like bone grafting and sinus augmentation may be recommended when enough bone is not available.

DENTAL RESTORATIONS

RESTORING THE BEAUTY BEHIND A SMILE.



Dental Restorations are tooth-coloured (composite resin) fillings to mend decayed or damaged teeth. Composite fillings chemically bond to the tooth structure. This means that minimal preparations can be made and valuable tooth structure is preserved. Dental inlays and dental onlays may be suitable in cases of significant loss of tooth structure.

PAEDIATRIC DENTISTRY

Paediatric dentistry takes care of the oral health of children from infancy through the teenage years. Paediatric dentists provide comprehensive oral health care that includes repair of tooth cavities or defects, care for dental injuries (for example, fractured, displaced, or knocked-out teeth), preventive dental care including cleaning and fluoride treatments, habit counseling like thumb sucking, early assessment and treatment for straightening teeth, correcting an improper bite (orthodontics) and making sports guard.

GENERAL DENTISTRY

FIXING SMILES; ONE TOOTH AT A TIME.



Oral health touches every aspect of our lives but is often taken for granted. That's why, we find it important to conduct a dental examination that involves a thorough clinical assessment of the health of the entire mouth with x-rays and photographs of teeth, if needed. We work with you to determine what your needs and goals are, and personalize a treatment plan to specifically meet them. Dental hygiene begins with a thorough cleaning of your teeth, which is known as scaling. For patients with advanced gum disease, a more extensive cleaning of the root surface and anti-microbial flushing of the gum pockets may be needed.

ROOT CANAL TREATMENT

SAVING YOUR TOOTH MEANS SAVING YOUR SMILE.



It's important to get to the root of the problem. Root canal treatment may be indicated in the case of pain, deep decay, infected tooth pulp or in trauma. This treatment involves removal of dead or infected pulp tissue from a tooth while maintaining the exterior structure of the tooth, cleaning, shaping and disinfecting the canals and subsequently filling of the canals.

CROWN AND BRIDGE

BRIDGE THE GAP, RESTORE THE SMILE.



We have a solution for all your dental problems. The dental crown is a tooth-shaped cap that surrounds the tooth or dental implant. They can be indicated to protect broken down or brittle teeth or enhance the appearance of severely discoloured teeth. Dental crowns are also recommended following root canal treatment to protect the dehydrated brittle tooth structure. Crowns are made from a variety of materials viz; ceramic, metal or a combination (Porcelain fused metal), zirconia, Leucite reinforced system, also popularly known as the "Empress Crown." A bridge is a fixed dental prosthesis used to replace a missing tooth or several teeth by joining an artificial tooth to adjacent teeth or dental implants.

DENTURES

A great set of teeth enhances every smile. Dentures are false removable prosthetic teeth that replace missing teeth. It could be conventional partial or complete dentures. There are many denture designs, some which rely on bonding or clasping onto teeth or dental implants.

ORTHODONTICS (BRACES)

IT'S TIME TO SMILE WITH CONFIDENCE.



A perfect smile with straight teeth is not only important for a healthy mouth, but it adds to one's confidence while improving the appearance of the face. The way the teeth align can affect the gums and dental health. Patients who have dental and facial irregularities should be taken care by an orthodontist. Orthodontic treatment will bring teeth, lips, and jaws into proper alignment for optimal facial balance. Orthodontic treatment at later stages in life can dramatically enhance appearance and self-esteem while also improving the health of teeth and gums. For adult patients with damaged or missing teeth, orthodontists can prepare smiles for cosmetic and restorative dentistry (such as veneers and implants). Several orthodontic treatment options are invisible lingual braces, traditional metal braces, and translucent ceramic braces, invisalign also known as clear-aligners.

SURGERIES – IMPACTION

BECAUSE SMILING SHOULDN'T BE A PAIN.



Evolution has rendered wisdom teeth, also called third molars, unnecessary in humans. If trapped in the gums, impacted wisdom teeth may lead to dental problems such as pain, infection or misalignment of other teeth, damage to the tooth in front, difficulty in cleaning. Impacted teeth that are not removed may lead to serious complications like cyst development around the tooth that may gouge the jawbone and damage adjacent teeth. Such teeth have to be extracted surgically.
